



Baritone **Jeremy Ludwig**, a recent graduate of the University of Toronto's (U of T) Opera School, can be seen regularly performing in the Toronto area, as well as in other cities across Canada. Highlights for the 2011-2012 season include Handel's *Messiah* with the Redeemer College Choir in Hamilton as well as his debut appearance with Toronto Operetta Theatre in Kálmán's *The Gypsy Princess*. Early in 2012, Jeremy will also be taking part in an exciting collaboration with the Toy Piano Composers, a collective of young and talented composers from across Canada in a performance of a series of brand new operatic vignettes. Jeremy's recent performances include appearances with Essential Opera, Summer Opera Lyric Theatre (SOLT), Opera Kitchener and Opera by Request.

Jeremy is also a member of the popular children's opera group Shoestring Opera, with whom he performs the role of Papageno in an adaptation of Mozart's *The Magic Flute* in schools in the Toronto area.

Jeremy holds a Bachelor of Music from the University of Western Ontario, and a Master's of Music from the University of Toronto's Opera School. He has also trained at the Centre for Opera Studies in Italy (COSI) in Sulmona, Italy, Opera NUOVA, The Canadian Operatic Arts Academy (COAA), and the Halifax Summer Opera Workshop.
